\$200 Grants for 2016-2017

- Current, fully paid-up members of ORA are eligible to receive these grants.
- A one-page proposal (which cannot be returned) should be submitted, telling how you would use the \$200 grant money to promote literacy in Oregon.
Please include a title for your project.
- The judges will use the following criteria in making their decisions:
 - The clarity and completeness of the proposal
 - The extent of the project's impact
 - Its value in promoting literacy
 - The use of effective literacy practices
 - The sustainability of the project after special grant funding
- The winners will submit a project summary with picture by May 15, 2017 for the ORacle. Winners should be willing to: share their projects at the ORA Winter Institute and/or for their local reading councils.

*Judging will be by members of the ORA Executive Board and others.
Winners of the grants will be notified by December 15, 2016
