ALL IN: The Role of Engagement in Comprehension

Can students be taught to understand? How do we engage students in deep understanding? Participants will explore new thinking about intellectual engagement and the relationship between engagement and understanding. We will discuss a range of ways in which teachers and students can share responsibility for engagement through the use of comprehension strategies.

Through their own reading and writing, discussion with colleagues, and the opportunity to observe a demonstration lesson with students, participants will learn a range of practical strategies to deepen understanding and engagement in learning.

Participants will:

- Discuss up to date tactics for teaching reading comprehension.
- Explore ways to help students deepen and extend comprehension of text and content area material.
- Learn to help students engage more completely in reading and learning.

DO OVERS and SECOND CHANCES: Helping Students Revisit and Revise Their Reading and Writing

Often teachers spend hours marking student work. It is discouraging when students don't want to reread text or revise their writing. They give their assignments a "once-over" and then rely on the teacher to "make them get it."

During this session, Cris Tovani will share how she uses literacy strategies, learning targets, matched assessments and feedback to help students re-enter their work to produce better products.
